"THE GREATEST GIFT"



In April of 1938, Philip Van Doren wrote the first draft of a short story titled *The Greatest Gift*, a universal tale for people in all times. Capra said, "It's the story of a man who thought he was a failure and who was given the opportunity to come back and see the world as it would have been had he not been born." As a predominantly non-fiction, historical based writer, branching into the world of fiction proved quite the struggle for Van Doren. So he gave the story a rest. He waited until the spring of 1943 before rewriting the story and showing it to his agent, who, despite her enjoyment of the piece, informed him that it

would be difficult to sell fantasy to any magazine. This prediction soon became truth, from *The Saturday Evening Post* to farm journals, it became clear that no magazine would touch the piece. Having become quite fond of his story, Van Doren revised it once again, and had 200 twenty-four page pamphlets printed at his own expense and sent out as Christmas cards in 1943. His daughter, who was in the third grade at the time, recalled delivering a few of the cards to her teachers and friends.

Then in March of 1944, the unbelievable happened. Van Doren received a telegram from his agent that they had received an offer from a well-known studio for the movie rights to *The Greatest Gift*. The offer had come from a man named Frank Capra, who was already an Oscar winning film director. After reading Van Doren's short story, he had become excited about its possibilities as a film and wanted Jimmy Stewart for the leading role. In an interview for American Film, Capra recalls a conversation with Charles Koerner, the RKO studio head. Koerner had told him about a story that he paid \$50,000 for. Capra's response:

"You paid \$50,000 for a Christmas card? Boy, I've got to see *that* Christmas card." Capra wrote about *The Greatest Gift*: "It was the story I had been looking for all my life! Small town. A man. A good man, ambitious. But so busy helping others, life seems to pass him by. Despondent. He wishes he'd never been born. He gets his wish. Through the eyes of a guardian angel he sees the world as it

would have been had he not been born."



The world premiere was held on December 20, 1946 at the Globe Theatre in New York. Initially not a box office success, over time *It's A Wonderful Life* has become a Christmas classic. In 2007, the American Film Institute ranked *It's A Wonderful Life* as number 20 in the 100 greatest movies of all time; in 2008, it was ranked 3rd among their top 10 fantasy films of all time.

After the film's premiere, Phillip Van Doren sent one of the original Christmas cards to Frank Capra, who replied: "I thank you for sending it, and I love you for creating it."
